



## Job Announcement: Station Manager for Rainier Valley Radio

### Background

SouthEast Effective Development (SEED) is launching Rainier Valley Radio | KVRU 105.7 FM, a low power FM station with internet streaming. Rainier Valley Radio | KVRU 105.7 FM will amplify the diverse voices of Southeast Seattle by airing programs created and produced by the community. The newly constructed radio station is located in the Genesee/Mt. Baker neighborhood. We offer a unique opportunity for a part-time Station Manager to facilitate the station launch and manage its operations.

### Position

The Station Manager is responsible for directing the day to day and long range efforts of the community radio station. The Station Manager will be responsible for the operations, as well as for financial and administrative oversight. Duties include but may not be limited to: the development of locally produced programs, ensure station compliance with FCC regulations, management of personnel, implementation of revenue generation strategies (underwriting, sponsorships and membership drives), serve as liaison to the community and public representative for the station.

### Qualifications Required

We seek a station manager who is positive and energetic about the opportunity to run a community radio station in Southeast Seattle. Ideal candidates will have at least five years of experience in the radio industry. Radio station management, operations or broadcasting experience are preferred. Qualified candidates will have demonstrated the ability to do community outreach, recruit talent, manage a staff, and meet financial goals. The ability to interact with diverse ethnic communities is very important.

The Station Manager will work closely with the SEEDArts Director and the Radio Leadership Council, a community advisory board, to make it successful. This position is for 20 hours/week, with pay based on experience up to \$20/hour. This position has the potential to grow into a full time position with benefits.
